National Sigma Tau Delta offers several ways for writers to be paid for their work:

Literary magazine awards \$300 each Scholarly paper awards \$150 each Editing/Publishing internships \$1500-\$4000

LITERARY MAGAZINE AWARDS

THE RECTANGLE is an annual literary magazine that pays \$300 for:

poetry short st

short stories

personal/informal essays

critical essays

writing of any genre

THE SIGMA TAU DELTA REVIEW, an annual, pays \$300 for critical essays on:

rhetoric and composition pedagogical issues essays on literature

Sigmas who are not interested in teaching can become editors, a career that offers great flexibility and mobility. There are internships, certificate programs, and graduate degree programs available.

National Sigma Tau Delta sponsors numerous internships at Regnery Publishing, a non-fiction publisher, Washington, D.C.

Six-week summer internships	\$1500
Three/four month fall/spring internships	\$4000

In addition to the usual Sigma application information, prospective interns must submit three pieces of writing: a writing sample, two short paragraphs describing professional/vocational goals, and an application essay describing why the writer is interested in interning in publishing.

Deadlines: Fall Internships 30 May
Spring Internships 30 October
Summer Internships 30 January
