1. Call for Concept Papers: NSF Major Research Instrumentation Program

The next submission window for the NSF Major Research Instrumentation (MRI) Program is **October 16 - November 15**, **2023**. The NSF MRI Program serves to increase access to multi-user scientific and engineering instrumentation for research and research training at institutions of higher education.

This is a limited submission opportunity. If you are interested in submitting an MRI grant proposal, you must email a 1–2-page concept paper to Kim Squiers in the Office of Sponsored Programs by **August 4, 2023**. CLAS Voyage

The Laker Accelerated Talent Link program is set to begin the inaugural year as part of CLAS' commitment to ensuring access to high-impact practices, such as internships, for all students. Internships are highly valued in the hiring process, and the CLAS Center for Experiential Learning, in conjunction with the GVSU Career Center, is helping to build those connections for students.

The Talent Link program offers equal access for CLAS and Brooks students to enhance their degrees through a certificate program and gain work experience, increasing their value to employers. It will provide employer-sponsored scholarships and paid internships during the winter semester for 25 qualified applicants.

Over 30 students, 72% of whom are from CLAS or Brooks, are interviewing for 25 positions with six employer partners (Amway, Acrisure, Corewell, Cascade Engineering, Michigan Software Labs, and GVSU) this summer. For more information, check out the Talent Link website.
