## Instructions for the IACUC Medical Questionnaire Form

Care and use of animals in research presents certain health and safety hazards. For your protection, the IACUC requires all animal caretakers, employees, and students working with animals to be evaluated by a medical professional before commencing their work with animals, unless determined to be exempt by IACUC. The evaluation can benefit the care and research staff as follows:

- It establishes baseline health information on employees before exposure to the risks associated with the research.
- Pre-existing conditions that might affect the employee's ability to safely perform the work might be identified.
- The evaluation may identify hazards requiring additional training or protective equipment.

The Medical Questionnaire Form will be reviewed by health professionals at the Grand Valley Campus Health Center and returned to the person who completed it. (Alternatively, you may have your personal physician complete the form.) Typically, a physical examination is not necessary. If you have any additional questions or concerns, please contact your PI, the GVSU Office of Research Compliance and Integrity, or GVSU's Lab Safety Specialist.
