- _____ GEO 112 – Earth History (4 cr.) (Prereq: a course in physical or general geology)
- _____ GEO 319 – Earth Science in Secondary Education (4 cr.)
(Prereqs: Earth Science major or minor, teacher certification candidate, and 18 credits in Earth Science)
- _____ GEO 320 – Geomorphology (Earth Science capstone) (4 cr.) (Prereq: GEO 112)
- _____ NRM 140 – The Climatic Factor (4 cr.)
- _____ PHY 105 – Descriptive Astronomy (3 cr.)
