	GEO 319 – Earth Science in Secondary Education (4 cr.) (Prereqs: Earth Science major or minor, teacher certification candidate, and 18 credits in Earth Science)
	GEO 320 – Geomorphology (Earth Science capstone) (4 cr.) (Prereq: GEO 112)
	NRM 140 – The Climatic Factor (4 cr.)
	PHY 105 – Descriptive Astronomy (3 cr.)
