If you have not been using Spanish regularly since any previous coursework, you are encouraged to take the language placement test or speak to a Spanish Faculty Advisor for assistance with appropriate placement.

Study Abroad: Spanish majors interested in teacher certification are required to study abroad for at least one semester (12-15 credits at the 300-level) in a Spanish-language study abroad program. Program must be approved prior to study abroad by a faculty advisor in Spanish and can be used to fulfill major requirement courses. This is applicable for students who start fall 2014 and later. Students who are unable to complete the study abroad requirement will need to complete an alternative plan approved by the Spanish Study Abroad Committee. Please meet with a Spanish faculty advisor as soon as possible to discuss your options. If you have previously lived or studied abroad, please contact your Spanish faculty advisor to determine if these experiences will work to fulfill the study abroad requirement.
