Implement closed captioning where possible

Review content accessibility through Blackboard Ally's accessibility checker

Remediate files using Blackboard Ally's guidance & consulting with eLearning and Emerging Technologies

Provide remediation support to faculty for inaccessible files

Partner with DSR to provide accommodation

Offer training to faculty in universal design for learning principles

Recommend captioning strategies and Panopto's auto-caption features

Review Blackboard Ally reports and relay to administration
