The Regional Math and Science Center at Grand Valley has developed an inter-generational summer camp program for grandparents and grandchildren. The camp, **Grandparents**, **Grandkids**, **Grand Valley (G3)**, is designed to be a collaboration among all colleges and departments interested in participating. The event is a three-day residential experience planned for **June 23-25**, **2015**, during which grandparents and grandchildren (ages 8 to 12) attend a series of sessions offered by GVSU faculty to showcase their discipline.

We are writing to invite you to be part of this program by designing and offering a 90 minute session for the camp. (You may choose to expand your session by offering a "part one" and "part two," however you must then be able to fill a time span of 180 minutes.) Our primary goal is to provide opportunities to engage participants in significant, hands-on learning. We encourage you to be creative and innovative. Additionally, we would like to broaden the students' perception of the panorama of academic opportunities in higher education. Finally, we want to provide a campus living experience and encourage students to investigate possible careers related to the sessions offered

If you are interested in offering a session, we ask that you complete and submit the attached Faculty Planning Form by October 31, 2014. We are asking for a title, session description, and various session requirements to help us build a compelling and inviting camp program. A tentative camp schedule, session guidelines, and a list of 2014 GVSU offerings are also included to assist you in planning.
