- 1. Students must apply in advance for each practicum course. Advisor approval is required. Apply online at http://www.gvsu.edu/coe/grad/app. Application deadlines: May 15 for fall enrollment, September 15 for winter enrollment, and February 15 for spring/summer enrollment.
- 2. All students must complete Responsible Conduct of Research training as a graduation requirement. This online training should be completed prior to completion of 50% of the graduate program or prior to engaging in any research activity. Certification expires after 3 years and must be current while engaged in any research activity. - 3. Michigan Department of Education requirements for supervisor and director approvals include a Master's degree, teaching endorsement or related service license for special education, and three years employment experience in special education.

## **Important Program Policies**

- Students must apply and be accepted for graduate study in the College of Education. Students who have not been accepted will not be permitted to enroll in coursework beyond 6 semester hours.
- Students who have not enrolled for 24 consecutive months must follow the program requirements in the GVSU catalog that are in effect at the time of their re-entry.
- This program does not result in a master's degree without completion of additional coursework.
- Students must earn a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher on GVSU graduate coursework. If pursuing a master's degree, a letter grade of "C" or higher is required for all courses used for degree.
- All candidates applying for certification or approvals must initiate the certification recommendation process by self-registering in the Michigan Online Educator Certification System (MOECS) at www.michigan.gov/moecs.
