- 3) Completion of this program will result in the Cognitive Impairment endorsement which can be added to a Michigan Standard/Professional teaching certificate - application required.

- * Students must apply and be accepted for graduate study in the College of Education and Community Innovation. Students who have not been accepted will not be permitted to enroll in coursework beyond 6 semester hours.
- * Students who have not enrolled for 24 consecutive months must follow the program requirements in the GVSU catalog that are in effect at the time of their re-entry.
- * This program does not result in a master's degree without completion of additional coursework.
- * Students must earn a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher on GVSU graduate coursework. If pursuing a master's degree, a letter grade of "C" or higher is required for all courses used for degree.
