Please do not jeopardize your goals by submitting your application late and/or incomplete.

Supporting Documents

ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER APPLICATION HAS BEEN SUBMITTED

The following must be included in your student teaching application. Applications must be complete at the time they are submitted, and submitted by the deadline.

Documents you must provide:

- Two copies of your up-to-date résumé (unstapled), with three references, current e-mail address with Teacher Assisting experience included (and Student Teaching if Special Education), on plain white paper. Please don't use color or shading on your résumé as it is scanned into a PDF file and emailed to Principals and/or Cooperating Teachers for potential placement.
- Generate a new "myPath" from Banner with your "G" number handwritten on it. If classes are being taken at another college, include a copy of that current course schedule with GVSU course equivalencies noted and highlighted.

Completion of Teacher Assisting with a grade of B- or better and positive recommendations at the completion of Teacher Assisting and Student Teaching if in a Special Education program.
