Application Requirements:

- ✓ GVSU Undergraduate Application – students must be admitted to GVSU and be eligible to start classes in the semester indicated on the application. Apply here: <https://apply.gvsu.edu/apply/>
- ✓
- ✓ Official Transcripts – You must have official transcripts from all of your current and previous colleges or universities sent to Grand Valley State University.
- ✓ Attend Transfer Advising and Registration (TSAR) – once admitted to GVSU student must register for TSAR. During this virtual one-on-one appointment, the student will meet an academic advisor to create a customized program plan and register for classes.

Admissions Considerations

- Overall academic grade point average must be greater than or equal to 3.0.
 - If it is not the last 15/16 credits will be considered.
 - All pre-requisite classes must be completed with a grade of C (not C-) or better.
 - Successful passage of NCLEX before the beginning of the 400 level NUR courses.

Progression Requirements

- All pre-requisite courses, BMS 310, PSY 101, STA 215 and WRT 150 must be completed before beginning the 400 level courses.
- Valid RN license to begin the 400 level courses.
- All required NUR courses must be completed with a grade of C (not C-) in order to progress in the program.
- No required courses can be taken for CR/NC.

Graduation Requirements

- Minimum of 120 credits
- Last 30 must be earned at GVSU
- Completion of the General Education program as outlined in MyPath
- 2.0 cumulative GPA required
