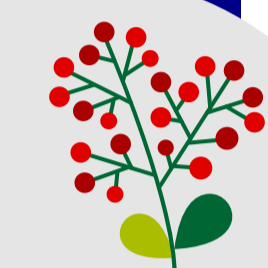

Step 1 - Getting Started

Gaining access to Blackboard and the courses which you teach is a crucial part of the educational experience. Using your GVSU network credentials, you can log onto [Blackboard](#) to access all of your courses. 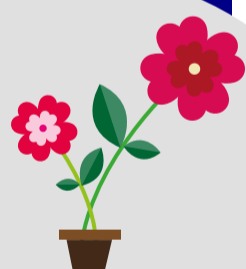
