GVSU participates in NSSE every 3 years. The survey measures students' engagement in educational practices that have been demonstrated to lead to greater learning. By design, the survey is limited to students in their first year of college and those nearing graduation. GVSU's participation rate in 2016 was 28%, higher than peers' (18%-20%), but lower than in previous years (43% in 2013). The results here have been re-weighted to represent the sex and enrollment status of the respective schools' populations.
