

## **POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT**

**Position:** Scientific Technician II – Annis Water Resources Institute

**Qualifications:** Master's degree in a field related to aquatic science, such as environmental science, natural resources, biology, or limnology; experience in the following: managing research projects, leading field investigations, collecting and analyzing samples in the field and laboratory; analyzing and managing data, supervising staff and students; working with website and social media; exceptional written and oral communication; and working in a collaborative, interdisciplinary setting. Preference will be given to applicants with experience working in aquatic ecosystems. This is a full-time position with benefits.

**Responsibilities:** Provide support to AWRI Director: manage research projects, supervise lab staff and students, and assist with overall lab administration. Research project management may include development of project budgets, work plans, and proposals; experimental planning and setup; coordination of field sampling; collection and analysis of samples; managing datasets; performing statistical analysis and reporting research project data; writing and proofreading scientific reports and manuscripts; and communicating with project partners. Additional responsibilities include serving as the AWRI webmaster, maintaining AWRI's presence on social media, overseeing AWRI field and laboratory equipment, coordinating AWRI's annual review newsletter, and providing training to faculty, staff, and students.
