John ran Shepard Broadcasting Inc. for over 50 years here in the West Michigan area and played a role in establishing WOOD-TV (Channel 8) and WOOD radio. WLAV-FM was among several radio stations in seven states that were owned and operated by Shepard Broadcasting for 20 years. Marjorie E. Shepard was a devoted wife to John for 51 years and was a great supporter of John's career goals. Their three children and seven grandchildren were the center of her life. Her community involvement included the Babies Welfare Guild, where she was an active member and longtime supporter.

Qualifications:

- 1. Undergraduate full-time students in the School of Communications, with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or greater
- 2. Applicants should demonstrate financial need by the completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 3. Preference will be given to students pursuing a career in broadcasting.
- 4. Scholarships are renewable up to four semesters (with re-application). Scholarship awards begin fall of the following academic year.
- 5. Individual scholarships are in the range of \$1,500.
