PAS Program Policy for Participation in Clinical Experiences during the Clinical Year

To participate in Clinical Experiences during the Clinical Year, all PAS students must

- 1. Wear appropriate professional attire as outlined in the PAS Program Student Professionalism Policy.
- 2. Bring their own medical diagnostic instruments (stethoscope, ophthalmoscope, otoscope, reflex hammer, etc.) to all clinical rotations.
- 3. Clearly display the University-provided nametag picture ID at all times during clinical educational opportunities.
- 4. Provide their own transportation to and from assigned clinical sites.
- 5. Pay for all lodging and other personal expenses during the clinical year.
- 6. Be aware that during some clinical experiences, students may be at risk of exposure to communicable diseases. Please refer to the PAS Program Student Exposure Policy for further details.
- 7. Adhere to the GVSU Health Compliance Policy at all times.
