### Summary

Byron Center Charter School opened in 1996 to provide families with an option focused on fundamental academics and character development. The academy offers kindergarten through 12th grade at one location just south of metro Grand Rapids. The academy believes a safe, disciplined, and academically challenging environment can be achieved with smaller class sizes, and is committed to ensuring a low student/teacher ratio is maintained.

# CSO Capacity Analysis

Byron Center Charter School continues to demonstrate solid academic, fiscal, and organizational performance. The CSO has observed that the academy's personalized instruction and small class sizes create a learning environment that is attractive to both parents and students. The CSO has observed that the academy board and school leadership are aligned, which has helped the academy retain a committed leadership team that remains faithful to academy's mission. Academically, the school continues to outperform its peer schools on the M-STEP proficiency, but has started to see mixed results with student growth. The CSO has confidence that BCCS has the capacity to sustain and improve its educational program during the remaining term of its charter contract.


