## **Team Competition Structure & Avogadro**

**Self-scheduling** is done online through Avogadro. Scheduling opens **Monday, March 3rd at 8:00 a.m.** and will close Sunday, March 26th at 12:00 a.m. Any changes to the schedule after this time must be done at the event site on tournament day. Alternate Teams self-scheduling registration begins Monday, March 10 at 8:00 a.m.

<u>Division B</u> & <u>Division C</u> Self Schedule Events time blocks.

#### **Avogadro** will be used for all teams.

- By default, we have set all teams to 'competing' in all events. Events must be set to 'Competing' to be scored. Only choose "not competing" if you are 100% confident you will not compete. Choose No Show. There is no penalty for

choosing competing and not showing up, but it is impossible to score if you choose 'not competing' and decide to compete.

- Self-schedule events Signing up is necessary to provide you with a score
  - \*Self-schedule events require teams to choose a time.
- **Team Members need to be added to Avogadro.** Please add your students under the Edit Team page, "Additional Team Details" add "Team Member." If this process does not work for you, please contact Jess Sudy at <a href="mailto:msor12@gvsu.edu">msor12@gvsu.edu</a>.
- Team member substitution forms available at registration day of.

Please ensure your team has a plan in case of **emergencies**. The coach is responsible for the behavior and safety of team members while on campus.
