These meetings are a great opportunity to check in on how things are going and to ensure you are set up for long-term success at GVSU.

You are able to view classes for Spring/Summer 2024, Fall 2024, and Winter 2925. Use the <u>Plan Ahead</u> function in Banner to make a plan for each semester. Then you will be all set to register at 7am on your registration date!

#### Considering taking summer classes at another school?

After the grades are posted from your summer class send the GVSU Registrar your official transcript for it to be updated on your myPath. # Optometry Career Spotlight


