#### **APPLICATION IS NOW OPEN**

The Traditional Nursing Program application opened on 8:00 AM on January 1st and closes at 5:00 PM on January 8th for admission into the Fall semester (August 2023).

The Second-Degree Nursign Program application opened on 8:00 AM on January 1st and closes at 5:00 PM on January 8th for admission into the Summer semester (May 2023).

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

The following requirements must be met in order to submit an application to the nursing program in January:

- Overall GPA of 3.0 or higher (including all non-GVSU courses)
- Admission pre-requisite GPA of 3.0 or higher
- An earned grade of 'C' (not C-) or higher in all pre-requisite courses
- Adhered to the KCON repeat policy that allows students to repeat three prerequisite courses (only two of those courses can be BIO, BMS, or CHM). No required course may be repeated more than once.
