Course Withdrawals

A student may withdraw from a course and receive a grade of "W" when dropping after the 100% refund deadline and prior to the end of the ninth week of the semester (March 22 at 5:00 PM).

Students who receive financial aid should consult the <u>Financial Aid Office</u> before withdrawing from any of their courses.

We strongly encourage you to consult with your Academic Advisor before withdrawing from any courses.
