
# When will I be able to register for classes?

Students can view their assigned registration date on <u>myBanner</u> by selecting **Student**, **Registration**, **Student Registration Self Service**, and **Prepare for Registration**. Students can begin registering for upcoming semesters at 7 AM on their assigned registration date. Class standing for registration is based on current class standing plus attempted hours being taken in the winter semester.
