#### LETTER FROM THE CHAIR

Welcome back! If you're like me, the summer went by in a flash. I hope folks were able to take some time off to rest and recharge.

This is shaping up to be a particularly challenging fall semester for LGBTQIA folks. LGBTQIA rights, especially trans rights, are a hot-button issue in what's already been an especially acrimonious election cycle, and that is focusing a lot of negative attention on the community both nationally and locally. We are already seeing the effects of this. Over the last 15 months, we've seen an uptick in incidences of hate speech on campus and some especially disturbing incidents that nearly escalated into physical violence. The climate is likely to become more volatile as we approach the election in November.

For those of us engaged in LGBTQIA advocacy work on campus, this has crystallized a longstanding need for more attention on the safety and well-being of LGBTQIA faculty and staff. There are systemic changes that desperately need to be put into place to improve campus climate, and will benefit all faculty and staff members, not just those in the LGBTQIA community. These changes include better and more consistent campus wide DEI training, especially for supervisors and those in evaluative positions, a complete overhaul of our grievance and complaint procedures, and more mechanisms to gather actionable data on workplace climate from current faculty and staff, in the hopes we can intervene in toxic workplace environments before we lose folks. We also want to amplify concerns about the prevalence of harmful hate speech on campus, such as those expressed by the student group Action Without Reaction in their comprehensive report on expressive activity (EA) on campus.

The steering committee and other community leaders on campus have had a lot of discussion over the summer about how to move those needs forward. In light of those discussions, the steering committee will be working towards better informing the community of the state of LGBTQIA advocacy work on campus going forward: where needs are, what work is being done, and how folks can get involved. This newsletter is part of that work. We are also focusing on reaffirming our commitment to creating community spaces where we can connect and decompress. Community building has always been a part of our mandate, but it's going to be especially important this semester.

We look forward to being in community with you over the course of the coming semester, lifting each other up, and trying to connect us all both to each other and the work that's being done on campus.
