ADVOCACY SPOTLIGHT

On behalf of the LGBT FSA Steering Committee, you're invited to our annual townhall event on **Wednesday**, **September 18**, **2024 from 11am-1pm on <u>Zoom</u>**.

The annual LGBT FSA Townhall is an opportunity for the LGBTQ+ faculty and staff community to hear from the FSA Steering Committee on updates related to LGBTQ+ advocacy on campus and for the steering committee to hear from you, the membership, about your priorities for campus advocacy.

The rough agenda for the townhall event is as follows:

- Welcome and Introduction of LGBT FSA Steering Committee Members
- Recap of last semester's attempts to add a Chick-fil-a on campus
 - What happened last semester
 - Where the issue stands now
 - o Open Q&A from members about Chick-fil-a situation

Queer Connections Mentoring Program

Mentors needed!

The LGBT FSA is seeking LGBTQIA+ faculty, staff, and graduate students to participate in **Queer Connections**, **GVSU's LGBTQIA mentorship program**. Queer Connections is open to all members of the university community but is specifically designed to match LGBTQIA+ undergraduate students with OUT faculty, staff, or graduate students.

Working with the Milton E. Ford LGBT Resource Center, mentors will be matched with LGBTQIA-identified students. Mentoring pairs will meet regularly over a six-month period during which time they will build connections, explore resources, and work toward collaboratively-constructed goals.

The LGBT FSA steering committee currently has an open seat and is in need of a candidate to fill it! The open position is for a treasurer/recorder, whose responsibilities include:

- Taking minutes at steering committee meetings and getting them to the communications officer to post on the website
- Helping the chair draw up agendas for and attending regular monthly meetings
- Keeping track of the FSA funds (Inclusion and Equity does most of the work, so this is not at all difficult)
- Assisting with the yearly budget request (the chair helps out a lot with this, so don't worry if you've never done it before)
- Pitching in on shared projects like the newsletter, coordinating events, etc.

The time commitment is generally just a few hours a month. Benefits include:

- Getting to work with the other awesome folks on the steering committee
- Meeting and forming relationships with other people in the community across campus
- Being more involved with advocacy work on campus
- Setting future directions for the FSA, including events, areas of focus for advocacy work, etc.
