




The *Keep Seniors Smiling* program is a Calhoun County program focused on providing access to dental services for low income County seniors

Dental coverage and increased access to dental care positively impacts health and well-being

DentaQuest Foundation 465 Medford Street Boston, MA 02129 In **state Medicaid programs**, there are often annual dollar limits (often \$500 to \$2,500) or procedure restrictions, e.g. limits on numbers of fillings or crowns, types of crowns that can be used on certain teeth, and how often root canals are covered.

<u>Calhoun County Millage: allowable</u> treatment may consist of, but is not limited to:

- Prophylaxis, and periodic recall when possible
- Tooth extraction
- Prosthetic services (dentures)
- Silver or composite fillings
- Abscess reduction by medication
- Abscess reduction by incision and drainage and medication
- Root canals and crowns (if deemed least invasive alternative and limited to two teeth)
- Fees for services are limited to published Medicaid covered rates plus a maximum of 15% additional incentive.




