- 28 Thousand
The Collection holds over 28,000 works of art, in all media. We collect artwork by students, faculty, alumni, regional, national, and international artists. There is a work of art that relates to your curriculum or department goals!
- 2nd Largest
The GVSU Art Gallery Collection is the second largest public collection in the state of Michigan. GVSU began collecting art in the 1990s.

- Explore
We explore the intersection of creative expression and critical thinking that connects to themes across all fields of study. Bring your class to an exhibition or bring artwork to your class! We also have many digital resources that can be used in the classroom or online which will allow your students to explore artwork through the lens of your curriculum.
- Discover
We install and maintain artwork across all GVSU campuses so that students, faculty, and staff are always surrounded by art.
