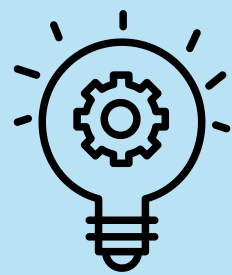


gvsU Need to Know
