MPNL Degree Requirements: The MPNL degree consists of a minimum of 36 credit hours of coursework. Precareer students should consider taking 3 credit hours of internship (PNH 690/691). Students must meet with the graduate program director upon entry into the program to develop a program of study. Full-time students can complete the program in four semesters. Part-time students taking two classes a semester can complete the program in six semesters.
