 - o NOTE from Kim: My team is working on new webinar preps for winter semester and one of the things I'd really like to do is to offer an opportunity for faculty to spend some time becoming more familiar with the Online/Hybrid Course Peer Review Rubric (Word doc). Our team continually refers to this rubric in our Foundations training, as well as when we are assisting faculty with developing their future online/hybrid courses, but we know lots of faculty aren't aware of this tool. It's such a good tool that can be used proactively, but I don't think enough faculty have really looked at it, unless they've needed to. I've got several faculty who are willing to talk about how they've used this tool with their peers and in their own work, but I'd love to have a member of OEMC who would be willing to participate and talk from their perspective. We haven't determined any 2022 webinar dates yet.
 - Additional note from Ellen: I would like to ensure there is someone there who can speak to faculty personnel process issues, as the rubric is required of reviews of teaching that are done online. Since UAS voted to 1) endorse this rubric that came

out of the OEC (a standing faculty governance committee) and 2) require it for online personnel review-related purposes, perhaps this would be something that OEMC or the FTLC (or both?) might want to co-host/co-facilitate?
