This position involves navigating students in the immersion process of interprofessional education and collaboration for completion of the IPE student certificate.

- Act as a liaison between students and MIPERC
- Coordinate IPE activities with other IPE champions (i.e. service learning events, Health Expo)
- Actively role model and advocate for interprofessional education within the university and the community
- Serve as a liaison to direct questions to the students sharing interprofessional common purposes
- Determine if a specific activity request from a student qualifies as an interprofessional experience
