The NIH has released new guidance that may be useful to researchers submitting NIH grants: [Allowable Costs Related to Participant Inclusion Activities](#). This document outlines examples of activities that NIH grant recipients can charge to their grants as allowable costs. Examples include reimbursing participants for transportation costs to the research site, advertising and public relations costs related to the study, and reimbursing participants for childcare expenses incurred while they are participating in the study.
