• Choose Your Own Skill Proposal

Members revisited the discussion about allowing Foundation and Cultures courses to choose their own two skills, rather than making them choose from designated skills. Foundations – Writing is not included.

Choose Your Own Skill is as follows: The GE Assessment for Skills is changing. Units offering courses in Foundations and/or Cultures can choose any <u>two</u> skills from the following <u>eight</u> skills:

- 1. Collaboration
- 2. Critical Thinking
- 3. Ethical Reasoning
- 4. Information Literacy
- 5. Oral Communication
- 6. Problem Solving
- 7. Quantitative Literacy
- 8. Written Communication

There are three qualifications:

- 1. All Foundation -Writing courses will continue to have Information Literacy and Written Communication hardwired into the category.
- 2. All Foundation and Cultures courses will retain their current skills, until a document that outlines how they will teach and assess a different skill is submitted to and approved by GEC
- 3. All sections of a course will teach the identical skills.

All Issues courses will continue to teach and assess Collaboration, Integration and Problem Solving; and no courses solely in Foundations and/or Cultures will teach and assess Integration.
