

If you are in the 2013-2014 catalog or earlier you can choose 2 Issues courses, or 1 Issues course and 1 Themes course, or 2 Themes Courses. You must choose 2 courses from 2 different disciplines. Only 1 course may be taken at the 100 or 200 level.

If you are in the 2014-2015 catalog or later you may NOT take Themes courses. You must take 2 Issues courses. You must choose 2 courses from 2 different disciplines.

If a course is crosslisted in two disciplines, your second course must be taken from a third discipline.

Issues Courses are only available for Issues credit on or after the effective date listed.
