PAS Program Student Drug Screening Policy

- 1. All PAS Program Students must comply with the <u>GVSU Senior Leadership Policy 5.1</u> <u>Alcohol and Other Drugs Policy</u> (https://www.gvsu.edu/policies).
- 2. A drug screen is required for scheduling clinical placements and by most health systems as defined in the GVSU <u>Health Compliance Policy</u>.
- 3. Students may be required to obtain repeat drug screening immediately before or during the clinical year.
- 4. Drug screening results are maintained in the student's health compliance account in Viewpoint.
- 5. The cost of all screenings is the responsibility of the student.
- 6. A non-negative drug screen may affect a student's ability to be placed at clinical sites and successfully meet program requirements. Non-negative drug screens are handled according to the GVSU <u>Health Compliance Policy</u>.
- 7. The Alcohol and Other Drugs Policy Handbook (www.gvsu.edu/aces) includes information about University drug and alcohol abuse prevention programs; health risks; counseling, treatment, and rehabilitation resources; legal sanctions and summary of laws; University employee and student sanctions for violations of alcohol and other drug policies; employee notification obligations; requirements for Federal grant recipients; and links to additional University policies, procedures, and resources.
