

## **PAS Program Student Drug Screening Policy**

1. All PAS Program Students must comply with the [GVSU Senior Leadership Policy 5.1 Alcohol and Other Drugs Policy](https://www.gvsu.edu/policies) (<https://www.gvsu.edu/policies>).
2. A drug screen is required for scheduling clinical placements and by most health systems as defined in the GVSU [Health Compliance Policy](#).
3. Students may be required to obtain repeat drug screening immediately before or during the clinical year.
4. Drug screening results are maintained in the student's health compliance account in [Viewpoint](#).
5. The cost of all screenings is the responsibility of the student.
6. A non-negative drug screen may affect a student's ability to be placed at clinical sites and successfully meet program requirements. Non-negative drug screens are handled according to the GVSU [Health Compliance Policy](#).
