PAS Program Student Professionalism Policy

- 1. All PAS students are expected to adhere to all university, college, and program policies and maintain professional standards in all interactions.
- 2. All PAS students are expected to adhere to the <u>Student Code</u>. The Student Code establishes standards of conduct to foster a community and environment where the mission, vision, and values of GVSU can flourish. These standards are embodied within a set core of values that include integrity, community, inclusion & equity, respect, and responsibility. The University's conduct process exists to protect the interests of the community and to challenge those whose behavior falls outside of these values and University policies.
- 3. The PAS student is a representative of the PA profession. The maintenance of a professional appearance is expected at all times.
- 4. PAS students are expected to maintain a professional demeanor in all interactions with classmates, faculty, and PAS instructors that fosters learning and demonstrates respect for the instructor and fellow students. Student(s) who disrupt classroom instruction may receive an initial warning or be expelled from the classroom at the instructor's discretion. A second disruption within the same class session results in the automatic expulsion of the student from the classroom. Any student expelled from the classroom or who has been disruptive in multiple classes is referred to the PAS Student Academic Life Committee.
- 5. PAS students are expected to maintain professional behavior in all clinical settings. Any student expelled from a clinical site is referred to the PAS Student Academic Life Committee.
