PAS Student Policy and Procedure for Disciplinary and Professionalism Review

- 1. All PAS students are expected to adhere to all university, college, and program policies and maintain professional standards in all interactions.
- 2. All PAS students are expected to adhere to the <u>Student Code</u>.
- 3. Students who violate these policies, procedures, or Student Code are referred to the PAS Program Student Academic Life (SAL) committee for disciplinary and professionalism review. The SAL committee consults with the PAS Program Director (PD) and/or the PAS Department Chair (DC) as needed. The SAL committee, in conjunction with the PAS PD and/or DC, shall take one of the following actions:
 - a. No action
 - b. Disciplinary warning (student notified in writing)
 - c. Disciplinary <u>probation</u> (continuation with conditions). The length of the probation is based on the nature of the violation.
 - d. Program Dismissal
- 4. A PAS student may be dismissed from the PAS program for any one of the following conditions:
 - a. Violation of the PAS Program Criminal Background Screening Policy.
 - b. Evidence of unethical or illegal behavior.
 - c. Students requiring disciplinary probation more than once.
 - d. Students who meet the criteria for disciplinary probation and are currently on academic probation.
- 5. The PAS program notifies PAS students of any disciplinary action taken within sixty (60) days of the PAS Program Student Academic Life (SAL) committee, PAS Program Director, or PAS Department Chair's notification of the event.
