## MKT 356-02

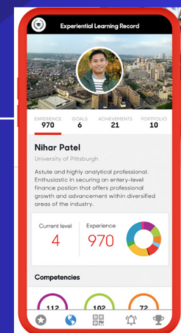
- The principles of professional salesmanship and their practical application in the marketing mix. Actual sales presentations by students are included.
