Program Requirements:

- An Honorably discharged veteran.
 - Documentation of military services DD214 required.
- Demonstrate a financial need
 - A copy of applicant's Student Aid Report from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Must currently be enrolled full-time at an accredited higher education institution or trade school certification program and proof of current academic standing
- Resume, including education, work experience, demonstrated leadership, recognitions and awards, and volunteer experience.
- Contact information for two professional references.
- A brief essay (500 words or less) answering the following questions:
 - Why did you join the United States Military?
 - What impact has your military service had on your life?
 - Describe how you overcame personal challenges to get where you are today.
 - If you were to give advice to a person five years younger than you, what would that advice be?
 - Given the opportunity, what problem in the world would you like to solve?
- Complete a FERPA release form for the purpose of processing and evaluating eligibility to participate in the WMA4V sponsored Veterans Housing Assistance Program.

About WMA4V:
