**Summary of recent changes:**

**Nov. 2024, effective SSu 2025:** MTH 324 (Fall only → Fall+Winter), MTH 305 (Winter only → Fall+Winter), MTH 350 (Fall only → Fall+Winter), MTH 402 (even Winter → odd Fall), MTH 450 (on demand → even Fall), MTH 296 (proposed new course, Winter only; subject to approval), MTH 313 (new course, Fall only); “Twilight” is no longer a promised category of classes (classes that start 4 pm or later), but most multi-section courses will still have sections starting 4 pm or later
